Meeting Point - BCS Stores Alvie Alvie Estate

DIRECTIONS TO ALVIE ESTATE

From the South - Turn off the A9 Perth to Inverness trunk road north of Kingussie and continue north on the B9152 for about 7 miles towards Aviemore. After going through Kincaig you will see a signpost on the right for 'Alvie' & 'Alvie Stables', turn left here, go through the tunnel under the main A9 road and onto the Estate. The Estate Office, cottages and various parts of the Estate are then signposted.

From the North - Turn off the A9 Inverness to Perth trunk road south of Aviemore at the junction signposted to Kincaig. Continue south onto the B9152 towards Kincaig. You will pass Loch Alvie on your right, followed by Dalraddy Holiday Park about a mile further on your left hand side. Continue along the straight road passing Alvie Quarry (GF Job). You will see an orange mirror on a tree on the left and 'Gate Lodge' on your right; continue on for a further few hundred yards, you will see a signpost on the left for 'Alvie' & 'Alvie Stables', turn right here, go through the tunnel under the main A9 road and onto the Estate. The Estate Office, cottages and various parts of the Estate are then signposted.

If your course is being held at Murthly Estate please read below:

Location – Murthly Estate, Murthly, Perthshire,

Meeting Point – McIntosh and Robertson Ltd, Gellyburn Quarry, Murthly, Perth PH1 4HL.

PLEASE NOTE: DUALLING OF THE A9 IS CURRENTLY TAKING PLACE IN BOTH DIRECTIONS BETWEEN LUNCARTY AND BANKFOOT, DELAYS MAY BE EXPERIENCED TO TRAVEL TIME.

From the South

Turn off the A9 Perth to Inverness Road at Luncarty (This will avoid roadworks). Drive through Luncarty, Stanley and you will then arrive into Murthly. Carry on through the village and you will pass a Nisa Shop on your left hand side, continue down and take the second turn off on your right into Broompark Crescent. You will then pass a small playpark on your left, continue straight on and then turn to the right up a small hill going into McIntosh and Robertson Ltd yard. Park passed the gates.

From the North

After passing Dunkeld, turn right off the A9 Inverness to Perth, road signposted B867. Follow the road, then turn left after 1.7 miles, signposted 'Murthly'. Follow the road until you get to a junction, turn right and then turn left into Broompark Crescent. You will then pass a small playpark on your left, continue straight on and then turn to the right up a small hill going into McIntosh and Robertson Ltd yard. Park passed the gates.
